CALL FOR ENTRIES

ELIGIBILITY

Any project of any scope constructed in the last six (6) years is eligible. This Awards Program is open to only AIAMB members who have been in good standing for the past two years.

Projects which have been previously submitted but have not received an award, may be submitted again. The jury may give Awards in several levels, including: Honor, Citation and Merit. The Jury will judge each project on its own merits, regardless of size or scope.

ENTRY PROCESS

Send in the ENTRY REGISTRATION FORM (below) and application fee of \$150 per project. There is an additional fee of \$50 per project to be considered for the Sustainable Design Award. Entry Forms must be postmarked by October 12, 2009. Upon receipt of your ENTRY REGISTRATION and fee we will send you an ENTRY BINDER for each project you have registered. The ENTRY BINDER will include detailed submittal requirements.

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

All of the exhibits and project summaries shall be submitted in both hardcopy (8-1/2 x 11" format) and electronic files (JPEG/ TIFF or WORDdoc).

Projects which are to be considered for the Sustainable Design Award must submit additional documentation describing the sustainable design features of the project. The additional documentation will be detailed in the Entry Binder.

Projects must be constructed within the past six years to qualify for the Awards Program.
